### Directions to Salvation Army Wonderland Conference Center, Sharon, MA



#### From the North

Take Route 95 South toward Providence to exit 10 (Sharon). Bear left on ramp, take left and follow to Route 27. Cross Route 27 and take your first right onto Pond Street, follow to rotary, pick up road straight ahead (Massapoag Avenue). Take to Capen Hill Road (first left after you pass the main gate of the camp). Wonderland Conference Center entrance is at the top of the hill on the left.

#### From the South

Take Route 95 North to exit 8. At stop sign, take a right. Follow Main Street (you will go through a set of traffic lights). The second street on the right after the light will be Ames St. (there is a red brick Baptist Church on the corner of Ames St.) Turn right onto Ames St. Go to the stop sign and take a right onto Pond St. At the rotary, go on road straight ahead (Massapoag Avenue). Take to Capen Hill Road (first left after you pass the main gate of the camp). Wonderland Conference Center entrance is at the top of the hill on the left.
